Extra Hot – you use a range of well selected adjectives, include a high level of detail and use connectives to make complex sentences.

Hot – you use a range of adjectives, include a good level of detail and use connectives to join up your sentences.

Mild – you include more detail, use a few adjectives and write in simple sentences.

Extra Mild – you include few details, use very few adjectives and write in simple sentences.
