# Web browsers

Software allowing viewing of content via the internet, usually web pages with multimedia content and applications.

- Opera

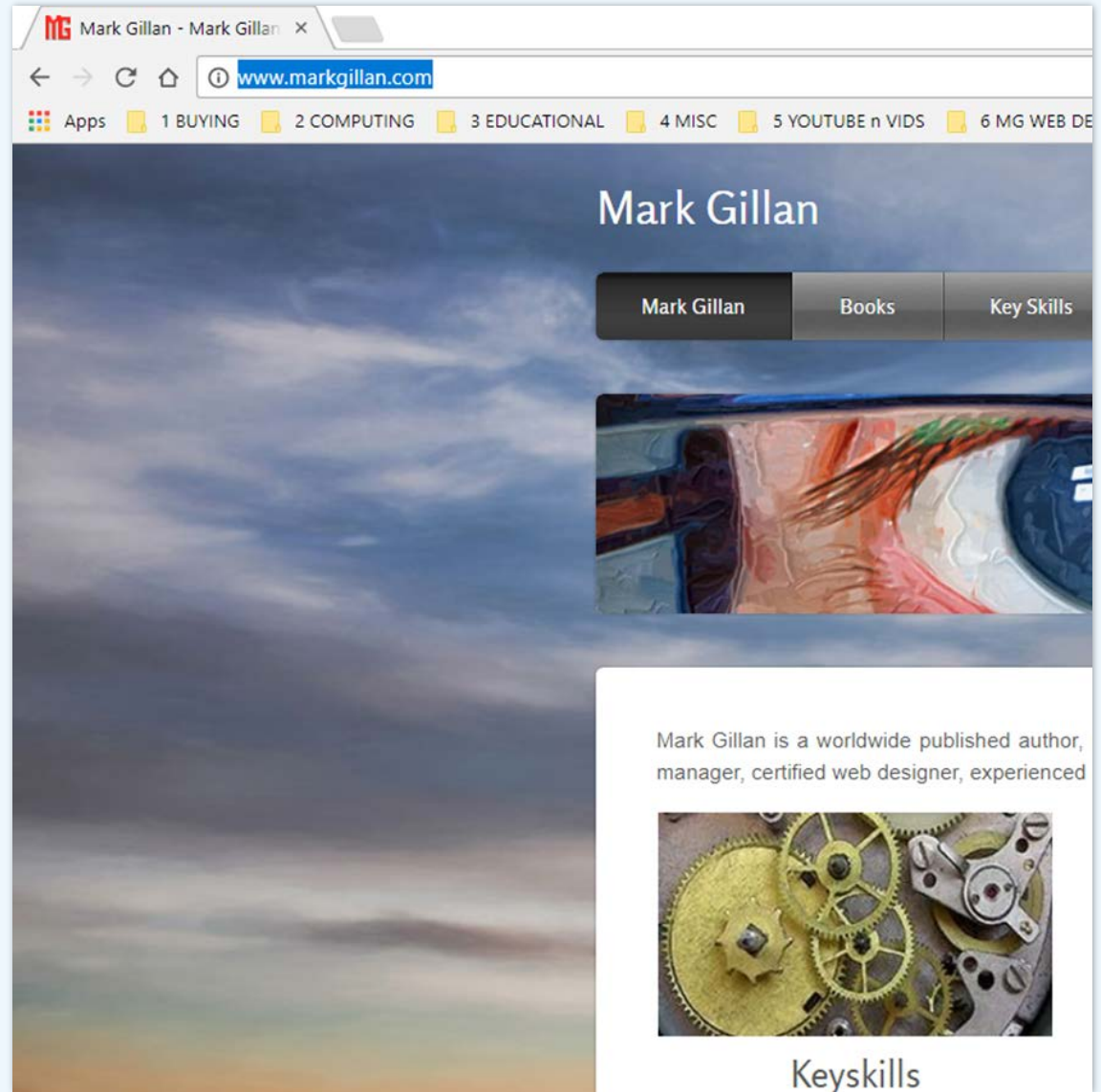

## Address bar

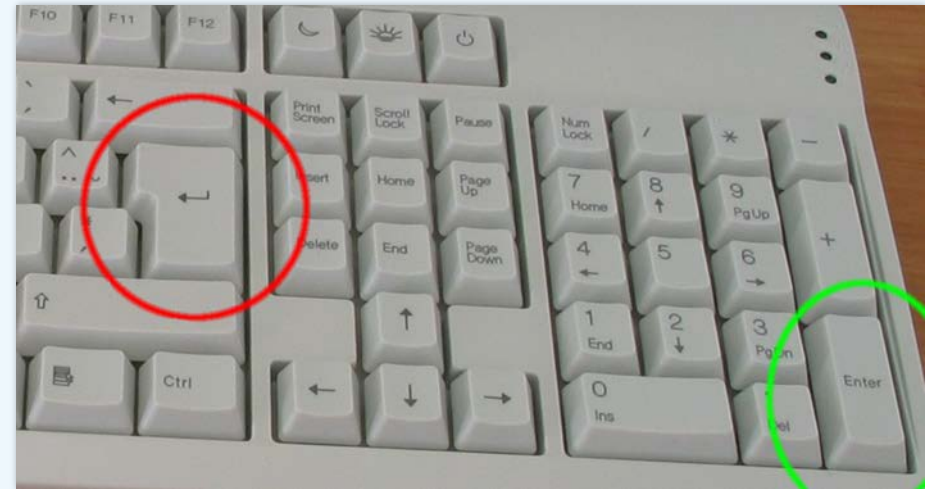
The address bar is usually located at the top of the window of most web browsers, clicking once in the middle of the current web address will select the address ready for input of another web address.

Once selected, the user can just start typing and the address will be replaced with the fresh typing.



# Go to another

- As mentioned, selecting the current web address makes the address bar ready for another
- Type another web address and hit the carriage return or enter key or indeed any enter button to go to the new web address
- This can be done many times
- Moving from one to another
- No need to close any web browser to start again
- Just keep moving from one to another of choice

# Web Browser Navigation

## Back button

- Use to step back to the previous web page

## Forward button

- After stepping backwards, this button will move forwards again

## Refresh button

- Usually an icon showing a movement around to return to the same place. This button is used to refresh. Pressing the F5 key on the keyboard is the same command and will refresh content on a web page, sometimes refreshing will fix errors

## Home button

- Pressing the button that usually contains a 'house' icon will navigate to the pre-programmed 'home' page being the starting page when the web browser is first run
