

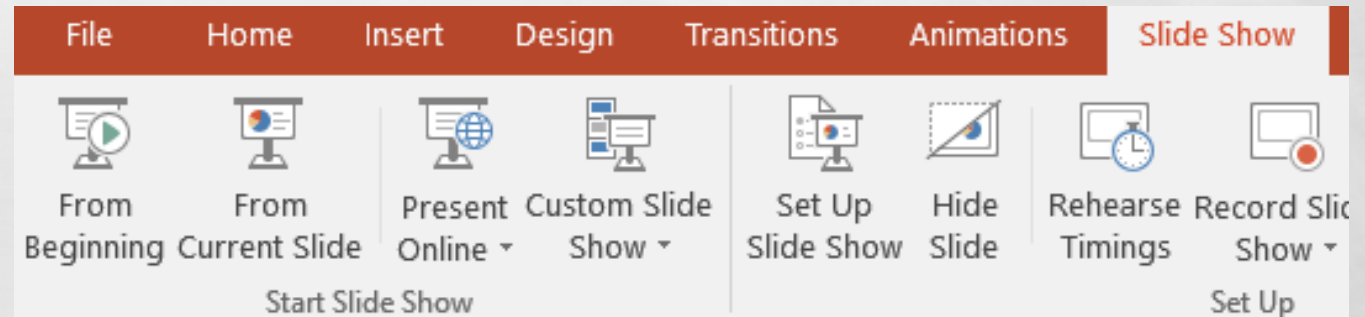
POWERPOINT TUTORIAL: SLIDESHOW

VIEWING

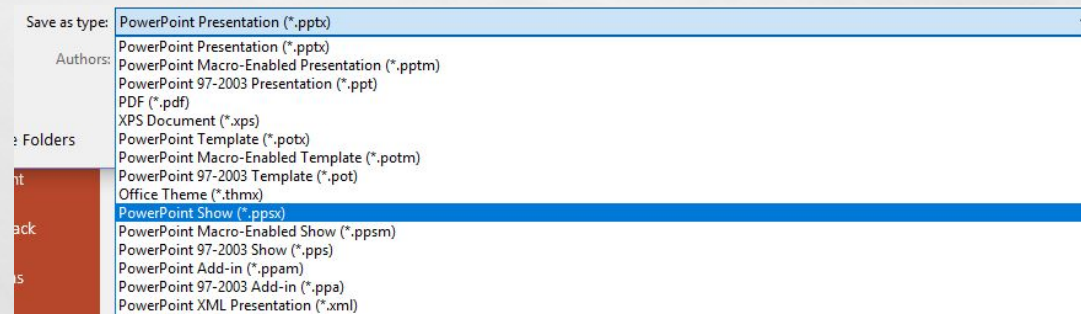
- A presentation can be viewed directly from the file itself by clicking on the 'Slide Show' menu for the slide show ribbon
- To test the slideshow appearance, transitions and animations – click either 'From Beginning' or 'From Current Slide' buttons available on the 'Start Slide Show' grouping upon the Slide Show ribbon



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FILE VIEWING

- An alternative to viewing a slideshow from within the application file is to use a file type to view the presentation directly from the first slide
- Save the file as a 'PowerPoint Show' (.ppsx) after saving the original PowerPoint file (.pptx) thus providing two different file types
- PowerPoint show files are easier, more attractive to an audience and offer a more efficient means for viewing or sharing the show
- Double clicking a PowerPoint Show file (.ppsx) within a folder will launch the presentation and will not display the ribbons or anything else from PowerPoint



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
