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HTML Validator

Standards

- ▶ Check HTML and CSS coding
- ▶ Not just a case of 'working' but needs to be as per standards and completely correct
- ▶ Coding can work in one web browser even if not totally correct in meeting standards but it could very well mean it does NOT work in other web browsers
- ▶ Remember accessibility guidelines and the principles of good web design
- ▶ Use the W3C validator to ensure standards are met and receive guidance

Validator service by W3C

- ▶ W3C validator can check a URI (URL) web address that is live online or a file by upload or by typing code into the validator. Notice the tabs for each.
